Subject: Procedure for Following Up On Proposed Orders

Ladies and Gentlemen:

If you have submitted a proposed order for entry and it has not been entered on the docket, you may take the following steps to determine the status of the order.

- 1. For most orders, allow at least five business days from the date of submission for the order to appear on the docket.
- 2. For orders granting requests for emergency relief and other time-sensitive orders which the Court has authorized the attorney to submit for expedited review, please upload the order using "Emergency/Expedited" as the type of order. Use of this designation will trigger receipt of an e-mail by Chambers staff notifying them that the order has been submitted and is ready for review. Please allow at least 24-48 hours from the date of submission (depending on the circumstances) for the order to appear on the docket.
- 3. If the order has not been docketed within the applicable time period set forth in paragraph 1 or 2, please contact the case manager assigned to the case. The list of case managers and their digit assignment is located on the Court's website (http://www.flmb.uscourts.gov) under Judges/Chambers.
- 4. Please **do not** contact Chambers without first following the steps set forth above. Otherwise, review of your order may be further delayed.
