ORDER THANKING 2001 RETIRING MEMBERS OF
LOCAL RULES LAWYERS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE
AND APPOINTING SUCCESSORS

In the Order Institutionalizing Local Rules Lawyers' Advisory Committee, No. 95-0005-MIS-TPA, entered on June 29, 1995, the Court established its Local Rules Lawyers' Advisory Committee, set forth the committee's charter, appointed the members of the committee, and established the manner in which the membership of the committee would be appointed. The Court notes that, pursuant to those provisions, the terms of three members of the committee expired on June 30, 2001, and that three new members of the committee are now to be appointed. Based upon and in consideration of the recommendations of the judges resident in the Jacksonville division, Orlando division, and Tampa/Ft. Myers divisions, the Court accordingly orders as follows:


1. The Court expresses its gratitude to the members of the committee whose terms have expired, Catherine Peek McEwen, Margaret Hull and Albert Mickler, for their able and beneficial service.

2. The Court appoints to the committee Bernard J. Morse, Anne-Marie Bowen, and Cynthia Jackson. The Court appoints Cynthia Jackson from the Jacksonville division, Anne-Marie Bowen from the Orlando division, and Bernard J. Morse from the Tampa/Ft. Myers divisions, for three year terms that will expire on June 30, 2004, or until their successors are appointed.

3. In view of Ms. McEwen's departure from the committee, the position of chair of the committee is also vacant. Accordingly, the court hereby appoints Roberta Colton, whose term on the committee expires on June 30, 2002, or until her successor is appointed, as the chair.
