**GENERAL ORDER ON AUTHORITY
TO INCUR AND PAY EXPENSES**


ORDER LIMITING AUTHORITY TO EXPEND FUNDS

THIS cause came on for consideration, ex parte, to consider the entry of an appropriate order concerning the administration of Chapter 7 cases in the Fort Myers Division. This Court considered the matter and finds that the trustees in the Fort Myers Division do file applications for authority to incur expensed, which are routinely normal and involve insignificant amounts. Therefore, it appears to be appropriate to dispense with the requirement of processing the paperwork relating to such matters. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the trustees in charge of the administration of Chapter 7 cases in the Fort Myers Division be, and the same are hereby, authorized to incur and pay expenses directly related to the administration of the estate not to exceed \$100.00 and to pay the same without further order of the Court. It is further,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the preliminary reports filed by the trustee shall itemize the expenses incurred and paid during the administration of the estate and shall be subject to review by the Court.
