ORDER DIRECTING COLLECTION OF CHAPTER 13
STANDING TRUSTEE FEES FROM PRE-CONFIRMATION PAYMENTS

This matter came on for consideration by the judges of the Middle District of Florida, Orlando Division, for the purpose of considering collection of certain fees by the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee. The judges resolved and agreed that the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee is entitled to collect his/her percentage fee as allowed by the United States Trustee from payments to secured creditors made in compliance with paragraph 4(f) of the normal Order Establishing Duties of Trustee and Debtor, and Confirmation Procedures, Ordering Debtor's Compliance, Allowing Administrative Expenses, and Ordering Adequate Protection Payments (the "Duties Order") entered in every Chapter 13 case filed in the Orlando Division of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida. Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee is entitled to collect his/her fees from payments made pursuant to paragraph 4(f) of the Duties Order.

It is also ORDERED that Administrative Order 96-0001-MISC-ORL is archived.
