**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER EXEMPTING JEANNE CHARN,
SENIOR LECTURER ON LAW, FROM PAYMENT OF THE FEE
FOR ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO COURT DATA**

The Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system is an electronic public access service that allows users to obtain case and docket information from the bankruptcy court and to view the pleadings directly. A fee is prescribed for electronic access to court data. The Court may exempt individual researchers associated with educational institutions from the fee if the exemption is necessary to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.

This Order is entered to exempt Jeanne Charn, Senior Lecturer on Law and Director of the Bellow-Sacks Access to Civil Legal Services Project, Harvard Law School, from the payment of the fees. This exemption is to promote important public access to information on bankruptcy filings and facilitate research regarding businesses and individuals who file for bankruptcy relief.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. Jeanne Charn, Senior Lecturer on Law and Director of the Bellow-Sacks Access to Civil Legal Services Project, Harvard Law School, is exempted from the requirement to pay fees for electronic access to court data in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida until November 20, 2009.

2. The information obtained via PACER may be used for research and scholarly publications, but may not otherwise be sold for profit.
