ORDER REAPPOINTING MEMBERS AND ADDING NEW
MEMBERS TO LOCAL RULES LAWYERS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE

In the Order Institutionalizing Local Rules Lawyers' Advisory Committee, No. 95-0005-MIS-TPA, entered on June 29, 1995, the Court established its Local Rules Lawyers' Advisory Committee, set forth the committee's charter, appointed the members of the committee, and established the manner in which the membership of the committee would be appointed.

The terms of five members of the committee, Roberta Colton, Traci Stevenson, and Michael Markham, from the Tampa Division, Richard Thames from the Jacksonville Division, and Glenn Jensen from the Orlando Division, expired on June 30, 2009; all of them have served with distinction and have indicated a willingness to be reappointed. In addition, the Court has determined that the work of the committee would benefit from expanding it to 12 attorney members.

Accordingly, in consideration of the recommendations of the judges resident in the Jacksonville, Orlando and Tampa/Ft. Myers Divisions, it is hereby

ORDERED:

1. The Court reappoints Roberta Colton, Traci Stevenson, and Michael Markham, from the Tampa Division, Richard Thames from the Jacksonville Division, and Glenn Jensen

from the Orlando Division, each for a two-year term that will expire on June 30, 2011, or until their successors are appointed.

2. The Court will expand the Committee to a total of 12 members and will appoint Gregory A. Champeau from the Ft. Myers Division, Lori Patton from the Orlando Division, Janet Thurston from the Jacksonville Division, and Kelley M. Petry from the Tampa Division, each for a three-year term that will expire on June 30, 2012, or until their successors are appointed.

3. Roberta Colton is reappointed as Chair of the committee.
