## REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT BANKRUPTCY ADMINISTRATOR

Middle District of Alabama

The current five-year term of Teresa R. Jacobs, United States Bankruptcy Administrator in the Middle District of Alabama at Montgomery, expires February 22, 2010. As authorized under *Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Governing the Bankruptcy Administrator Program*, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit has established a review committee to consider whether Ms. Jacobs should be reappointed to a new five-year term.

The bankruptcy administrator is responsible for supervising trustees and debtors in possession and assuring that such persons effectively administer estates in cases in the district under Section 1334 of Title 28, United States Code.

Members of the bar and public are invited to comment on whether Ms. Jacobs should be recommended by the committee for reappointment by the Court of Appeals. All comments will be held confidential and should be submitted to James P.
