OPPORTUNITY TO DECLINE NOTICES OF ELECTRONIC FILING

Attorneys in adversary proceedings have traditionally received Notices of Electronic Filings for the adversary proceedings in which they are directly involved and for their related bankruptcy cases. On **June 11, 2012**, the Middle District of Florida Bankruptcy Court will offer a new option that allows attorneys in adversary proceedings to opt out of certain e-mail notifications in the related bankruptcy case.

This election will stop all of the attorney's e-mail notifications, both the primary and secondary e-mail addresses, from the related bankruptcy case, provided the attorney has no direct involvement (e.g., no documents were electronically filed in the related bankruptcy case). **This is a global decision and applies to all adversary proceedings where the attorney is involved.**

Courts may override this option in some instances if the Court has identified certain events in the bankruptcy case that should be noticed to all parties in all related cases. Attorneys who opt out will still receive notification on the following events in the Middle District of Florida Bankruptcy Court even though these events would be filed in the main bankruptcy case:

Order on Motion to Approve Compromise under Rule 9019
Motion to Dismiss Case
Address Change
Motion to Convert
Appeals
SSN Updates

To decline notification in related bankruptcy cases, select **Utilities > Maintain Your ECF Account** from the blue menu bar in CM/ECF. Select "**Email information...**" and activate the "**Send notices for adversary proceedings in which I am directly involved but not for their related bankruptcy cases**" radio button:
