

3. Form Order Granting Debtor's Motion to Determine Secured Status of Claim and Void Junior Lien.

Paragraph 3 of the *Form Order Granting Debtor's Motion to Determine Secured Status of Claim and Void Junior Lien* is revised to be consistent with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3002(c)(3). Rule 3002(c)(3) extends the claims bar date for an unsecured claim that becomes allowable as the result of a judgment to thirty days after the judgment become final if the judgment avoids an interest in property. Paragraph 3 of the form Order now reads:

If Creditor has filed a Proof of Claim, it shall be treated as an unsecured claim. If

Creditor has not filed a Proof of Claim, Creditor may, as authorized by Federal Rule

of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c)(3), file an unsecured claim within 30 days of the
