The incumbent will conduct legal research, help prepare case research, and draft memoranda for the judge at the direction of the judge's law clerk. In addition, the incumbent will also observe hearings and trials held before all of our judges, meet with a representative of the United States Trustee's office, observe a § 341 meeting of creditors, and participate in training and networking events hosted by local bar associations.

Applicants must be a law school graduate; have taken a bankruptcy law course; have taken the Bar exam or scheduled to take the exam in February; possess excellent research, writing, and proofreading skills, and a graduation ranking in the upper third of their class is preferred.

Important Information

- This position is **unpaid**. The court cannot reimburse any travel, living, parking, or other-related expenses. Candidates must be able to work 20 hours per week.
- If you are selected, you will be required to submit fingerprints and undergo an FBI criminal background check prior to the start of the position.
