

Rule 3002-1

TIME FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM IN REINSTATED CASES

If a case is dismissed before the deadline for filing proofs of claim has expired and the case is later reinstated, the deadline in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3002(c) for filing a proof of claim is modified as follows:

(a) ***Dismissal Before § 341 Meeting.*** In a case that is dismissed before the § 341 meeting is held, the new deadline for filing a proof of claim or interest shall be the later of 60 calendar days after the rescheduled § 341 meeting or the original deadline for filing a proof of claim.

(b) ***Dismissal After § 341 Meeting.*** In a case that is dismissed after the § 341 meeting is held, the new deadline for filing a proof of claim or interest shall be the later of 60 calendar days from the date of entry of the order that vacates the order of dismissal and reinstates the case or the original deadline for filing a proof of claim.

Notes of Advisory Committee

2016 Amendment

This amendment extends the deadlines for filing proofs of claim in reinstated cases from 28 to 60 days and is now applicable to cases filed under all chapters. This amended rule is effective July 1, 2016.

2012

This rule provides for new deadlines for filing proofs of claims in bankruptcy cases that are dismissed and thereafter reinstated before the expiration of the claims bar date.

This rule is effective March 15, 2012.
