ORDER GRANTING [Creditor's Name] RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY

THIS CASE came on for hearing on [Hearing Date] upon the motion for relief from stay filed by [Creditor] (Doc. No. ____) ("Motion"). For the reasons stated in Court, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The automatic stay arising by reason of 11 U.S.C. § 362 is terminated as to the Movant's interest in the following property:
