The U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida (Court) is requesting quotations for the items described below.

Using the quote sheet provided herein, submit your quotation via email no later than the date and time specified above. Late quotations will not be considered unless the Judiciary determines, in its sole discretion, that consideration of the late quotation is in the Judiciary's best interest and will not unduly delay the procurement process.

The Court intends to award a **firm-fixed-price** purchase order to the responsible vendor submitting the **lowest-priced, technically acceptable** quotation. All items shall be quoted on a fixed-price basis and delivered **F.O.B. Destination, Inside Delivery to Consignee's Premises**. Unless more favorable terms are offered, payment terms shall be Net 30 days after receipt of a proper invoice and acceptance of the supplies.

Delivery is required within forty-five (45) calendar days after receipt of order (ARO) or no later than August 24, 2026, whichever occurs first.

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The U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Florida ("Judiciary") is seeking quotations for the items identified below.

The requirement consists of a Base Requirement and two (2) Option Requirements. For evaluation purposes, the Judiciary will determine the total evaluated price by adding the price of all option items to the price of the Base Requirement. Evaluation of option items does not obligate the Judiciary to exercise any option.

Options may be exercised at the time of award or at any time through December 31, 2026, subject to the availability of funds. No additional solicitation will be issued for the option items. If an option is exercised after contract award, delivery of the option items shall be required within forty-five (45) calendar days after the Contractor's receipt of the Judiciary's written notice exercising the option, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties.

Delivery Requirements

The Judiciary requires delivery of all Base Requirement items within forty-five (45) calendar days after receipt of order (ARO) or no later than August 24, 2026, whichever occurs first.

The Judiciary will evaluate offers equally with respect to delivery when the proposed delivery schedule meets the required delivery period stated above. Offers proposing delivery beyond the required delivery period may be determined unacceptable and rejected from further consideration. The Judiciary reserves the right to make award based upon either the required delivery schedule or an earlier delivery schedule proposed by an offeror. If an offeror does not propose an alternate delivery schedule, the required delivery schedule stated herein shall apply.

Failure to Deliver

If the Contractor fails to deliver the products or perform the services within the time required by the contract, including any authorized extensions, the Judiciary may, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies available under the contract:

1. Require the Contractor to expedite delivery or performance at no additional cost to the Judiciary;
2. Obtain similar products or services from another source and hold the Contractor liable for any excess costs reasonably incurred by the Judiciary; or
3. Terminate the contract, in whole or in part, for default in accordance with the contract's Termination for Default clause.

The Contractor shall not be liable for delays resulting from causes beyond its reasonable control and without its fault or negligence. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing as soon as practicable after becoming aware of any such delay and shall provide sufficient

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information regarding the cause, anticipated duration, and actions being taken to mitigate the delay.

Acceptance of late delivery or performance by the Judiciary shall not constitute a waiver of any rights, remedies, or contractual requirements.
