I am counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for The Center for Special Needs Trust Administration (the "Debtor") in the above-referenced matter. On February 9, 2024, the Debtor filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code initiating the bankruptcy case. On March 4, 2024, the United States Bankruptcy appointed a creditor's committee of five representative members to represent the interests of unsecured creditors in this case. It has been brought to the Committee's attention that some of you may have been contacted by unknown persons seeking to purchase your bankruptcy claims.

Please be advised that, while such bankruptcy claim purchasing is authorized, the Committee strongly recommends you consider contacting an attorney to discuss any such transactions relating to your claims, due to the potential loss of benefits that could result.
